From childbirth to scorned love, *Voices* is a show that puts women front and center. The latest show from Little Opera On The Prairie (LOOP) is getting set to hit the stage **March 10 & 12, 2016** hot on the heels of International Women’s Day 2016.

This isn’t your average evening of opera the show features 3 pieces that celebrate the female experience. Stories of women like Eve and Lilith interwoven with beautiful scores, poetry by Lorna Crozier and Elizabeth Raum set to music explore the female experience in both French and English.

In the opera *La Voix Humaine* a woman struggles with a final phone call to her ex-lover who has left her alone and suicidal.
